P2P's Board of Directors has appointed Tracy Knight and Damien Lau of Bentleys Corporate Recovery as the voluntary administrators of the company as well as two of its subsidiaries, Taxi-Link Pty Ltd ACN 103 522 372 (**Taxi-Link**) and TGT No 1 Pty Ltd ACN 160 154 209 (**TGT**).

The network division, Black & White Cabs has been recapitalised and will continue to operate as usual.

The Board of Directors regrets having to place P2P into voluntary administration and acknowledges all the affected staff for their hard work and dedication.
