• Organic certification now achieved on all Group farms

• Organic A2 milk production secured for the Group's organic A2 infant formula range

The Board of Australian Dairy Nutritionals Group (**AHF**) is pleased to advise that the Group has achieved another important milestone with all the Group's farms now certified organic following the 3-year conversion program commenced in 2018.

In addition to the organic certification, the Group has also been establishing A2 herds on all of the farms to ensure it maintains security of its supply of organic A2 protein milk, a very scarce raw material in the current market. The Group's Brucknell South and Yaringa farm run a certified organic A2 herd allowing production of certified organic A2 raw milk whilst the Bucknell North farm herd can be transitioned to certified organic at any time with 6 months' notice.

AHF CEO Peter Skene said "this has been no small task, requiring significant investment in soils and pasture, significant changes in farming knowledge and practise as well as the passion and persistence of our people. I would like to thank all involved in this journey and particularly our farm management team and staff".
