[^] Includes the votes of shares the subject of withdrawal requests made pursuant to Takeover Panel Orders. The subject shares were voted both by the registered holder (WAM Active Limited) and separately (in a different direction) by the beneficiary of the withdrawal right. As the votes were not determinative on any Resolution, the Chairman of the Meeting declined to make a determination on the voting challenge and, accordingly, the numbers represented above reflect the votes cast by the registered holders at the relevant proxy cut-off date.
