## **Sensera Quarterly Activity Report and Appendix 4C**

### **HIGHLIGHTS:**

- **Sale of MicroDevices business assets for US\$7.5m completed on 4 January 2022**
- **Q2 unaudited revenue US\$828k and cash receipts of US\$797k**
- **Board evaluating business opportunities**

Sensera Limited (Company) (ASX:SE1) is providing its Quarterly Activity Report and Appendix 4C for the second quarter of FY22 (Q2).

The Company's quarter end cash position was US\$308k. On 4 January 2022, the Company announced that the sale of the MicroDevices business assets had settled for US\$7.5m of which US\$1.9m was used to pay out an equipment lease and a further \$0.6m was required for creditors and one-off costs for the discontinued business.

Cash used in operations was lower in Q2 at US\$631k (Q1: US\$1,191k) primarily due to higher revenues/collections, lower manufacturing spending levels and a deferment of some creditors as detailed above. Cash used in operations comprised Microdevices of US\$541k and the Australian parent entity of US\$90k.

Whilst Q2 collections were US\$797k (Q1: US\$408k), the recoverability of approximately US\$200k of contracted prior period receivables is in doubt but is being pursued.

Payments to related parties, comprising director fees during the quarter totalled US\$45k.

Future cash flow reporting is likely to switch to Australian dollars as the US subsidiary's business operations have now ceased.

The Sensera Board continues to investigate opportunities and will make further announcements around these matters in due course.
