### **Midway to exit its logistics business in Western Australia**

Midway Limited (the Company), one of Australia's leading forestry management and woodfibre exporters, has decided to wind-down and exit its logistics business in Western Australia.

Midway Managing Director, Tony McKenna, said a lot of effort has gone into building strong relationships with customers and suppliers for Midway Logistics, but the Company cannot justify investing additional resources to grow the business in the current environment.

Mr McKenna said the decision to exit the logistics business in Western Australia is difficult for staff, contractors and customers but it is in the best interest of Midway shareholders.

Midway acquired its logistics business in Western Australia in October 2018. Its operations have been hindered by the COVID-19 pandemic supply disruption including labour shortages and more recently increased fuel costs.

This announcement has been approved by the Midway Board of Directors.
