Instead, it will be incumbent upon Connexion to market its approved product directly to Ford and Lincoln dealerships.

Notwithstanding the challenges noted above, Ford's approval of the Connexion platform is an important milestone as the Company enhances its direct-to-dealer relationships across the United States.
