## **RESULTS OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING (EGM)**

Australian Dairy Nutritionals Group (**AHF or Group**) advises that the Extraordinary General Meeting convened by certain securityholders under section 249F of the Corporations Act was held online today, 18 November 2022.

All resolutions were voted for by proxy or poll at the meeting. Securityholders voted **AGAINST** all 6 resolutions. A detailed breakdown of the results of each resolution are set out below and attached.
