Ansell On-Market Share Buyback Program

Ansell is continuing its on-market buyback program, to maintain flexibility with regards to its capital management strategies, and now does so under a new on-market buyback ASX notification. Accordingly, Ansell lodged an Appendix 3C "announcement of buy-back" which sets out required details for the buy-back next 12 months. Ansell intends to buy back shares when it is opportunistic to do so and in all cases below the 10% limit in the Corporations Act.
