Cybercrime – Bannister Law OAIC representative complaint

Medibank has today received a letter from Bannister Law which states that it now intends to lodge a representative complaint against Medibank with the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner ("OAIC"). Medibank is currently considering Bannister Law's letter and intends to respond as requested.

Medibank is not aware of such a complaint having yet been lodged with the OAIC and has not been contacted by the OAIC in relation to the complaint.

As previously announced, Medibank will continue to cooperate with the OAIC and its ongoing investigation.
