ANZ allocates \$1.5 billion under ANZ Capital Notes 8 Bookbuild; Margin set at 2.75% p.a.

Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited (**ANZ**) today announced that it had brought forward the ANZ Capital Notes 8 Bookbuild and has allocated \$1.5 billion of ANZ Capital Notes 8, with the Margin set at 2.75% per annum.

The ANZ Capital Notes 8 offer is being made under the prospectus lodged with ASIC on 15 February 2023 (**Prospectus**). A replacement prospectus reflecting the Margin and revised offer size will be lodged with ASIC on Thursday, 23 February and will be available within Australia at capitalnotes.anz.com.

Investors applying for ANZ Capital Notes 8 should speak to their Syndicate Broker regarding their application, read the replacement prospectus in its entirety and will need to complete an application form accompanying the replacement prospectus.
