## Field Solutions lights up new network in Western Australia Wheatbelt

Field Solutions Holdings (ASX: FSG), Australia's leading rural, regional, and remote telecommunications carrier, is pleased to announce it has completed the first of four network builds in the WA Wheatbelt.

"After two years of planning and permitting, we're excited to launch this first of several new networks in Western Australia," Andrew Roberts, CEO FSG said. "FSG has committed significant investment to developing new networks which deliver premium connectivity including internet, mobility and IoT to underserved agricultural and mining areas in WA." Roberts added, "FSG's investment, combined with support from local government, state government (DPIRD) and Commonwealth programs, will see this network deliver new opportunities and efficiencies for homes and businesses in the WA wheatbelt."

This investment represents the first infrastructure internet project constructed by FSG in Western Australia and complements the recent acquisition of a complimentary network in the Shire of Gnowangerup to create greater reach and network reliability across the region.

FSG's new networks deliver "city equivalent" broadband speeds, reliability, and price, in line with our mission as the leading Rural, Regional Remote telecommunications carrier. In addition, as Australia's 4th Mobile Network Operator, FSG's networks are built "RAN ready". The Regional Australia Network, or RAN, delivers internet broadband, 4G/5G Carrier Neutral mobile services and IoT from a single site, thereby extending real coverage in the most cost and time efficient manner.

Dumbleyung Shire President Julie Ramm said, "The Shire of Dumbleyung has been a significant supporter and sponsor to this important project with Federal Government Drought Communities grant funding allocated as an approved Shire financial contribution." 'The new network will have the capacity to deliver enterprise-grade fast speed internet connectivity for users that can obtain a direct line of sight access to each tower."

The Dumbleyung town will also benefit from improved services delivered from a new mast on the Shire Admin Building. This will enable the Shire and other residents and businesses in town to subscribe to faster, more reliable internet services from FSG.

The network will be officially launched at an event which will be held on 22 June at the Dumbleyung CRC (Community Resource Centres).
