Request for Trading Halt
Aussie Broadband Limited (ASX:ABB)

Aussie Broadband Limited (ASX:ABB) (**the Company**) requests a trading halt in relation to the trading of its ordinary shares quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.
