New Plant Arrives at Yerbas Buenas to Scale Up Production and Sales

- State-of-the-art screening and crushing plant and equipment that facilitates a major scale-up of operations at the Yerbas Buenas project has arrived on site
- Plant expected to be fully operational by end of February/very early March to meet supply commitments from recent new purchase orders and new purchase orders pending
- The plant also gives Freehill the processing infrastructure to recommence magnetite mining at Yerbas Buenas following the implementation of a new mine plan.

Freehill Mining Limited (ASX:FHS 'Freehill' or 'the Company') is pleased to confirm that the state-of-the-art material processing plant recently acquired has now arrived on site at Yerbas Buenas and is expected to be operational by the end of February or very early March (see images 1-4 below of plant mobilising to site and arriving at Yerbas Buenas).

As advised, combined with the existing plant at Yerbas Buenas, the expanded plant will increase Freehill's supply capacity considerably and give it the sorting, crushing and processing capacity to now supply multiple forms of material critical for cement manufacturing and construction purposes. There is considerable demand for this material from a number of cement plants and construction companies operating in and around the La Serena region where the Yerbas Buenas project is located.

Recently secured purchase orders and some pending orders can now be readily fulfilled given the added capacity. This will also result in the company's sales increasing materially.

As well as construction materials, the plant also provides Freehill with the added processing capacity to recommence magnetite mining at Yerbas Buenas which will be underpinned by much more robust mine planning and a number of potential customer supply arrangements.

Non-Executive Chairman Ben Jarvis said: "The new plant gives Freehill the ability to produce multiple products more rapidly and in much greater quantities to meet growing customer demand. Freehill is in the enviable position of now being able to service large and well respected companies operating in Chile's construction and infrastructure sectors that require reliable supply of different materials sourced from Yerbas Buenas. With the plant now on site and being near operational, operations will continue to scale up."




Image 1: Plant load-out from previous site where plant was located 1,500km from Yerbas Buenas
