
## Sales update for Q4 FY2024

**Melbourne, Australia & Hatfield, Pennsylvania:** CurveBeam Al Limited (ASX: CVB "CurveBeam Al" or the "Company"), a fully integrated developer and manufacturer of point-of-care specialised weight bearing CT imaging (WBCT) equipment, supported by a range of Al-enabled SaaS-based clinical assessment solutions, is pleased to announce an update from its 30 April 2024 releases regarding purchase orders¹ received during Q4 FY2024.

The Company is pleased to report 10 purchase orders were received during the quarter. This included:

- 7 HiRise<sup>™</sup> purchase orders (4 of which were in the US market)
- 3 purchase orders for other devices such as LineUP<sup>®</sup> and PedCat<sup>®</sup>

This higher level of purchase orders is showing a positive trend from the previous quarters with increasing market adoption of the Company's WBCT devices.
