- The contract will run for an anticipated 9 months and has a value of circa USD\$0.5 million. Refer Table 1 below.
- The JV will be responsible for contract payments with the terms requiring installments by the JV, which is 100% funded by MRG's JV partner, Sinowin Lithium (HK) Co., Ltd and SINOWIN Lithium Cobalt (ShenZhen) Ltd.
- This contract forms an integral part of the ongoing process of securing the mining licence and progressing the project to production.
