Axel REE Limited – Request for Trading Halt

Axel REE Limited (**ASX: AXL**, “Axel” or “the Company”) requests a trading halt in relation to the Company’s ordinary shares (**AXL**) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.

The trading halt is requested pending an announcement by the Company to the market in relation to material exploration results at the Company’s Caladão Project (**Purpose**).

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the Company provides the following information in relation to the request:

1. The trading halt is necessary to assist the Company in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as the Company expects to make an announcement to the market in relation to the stated Purpose above.
2. The Company requests that the trading halt remain in place until the earlier of:
 - (a) Such time as the Company makes an announcement to the market in relation to the stated Purpose above; or
 - (b) The commencement of normal trading on Wednesday, 11 December 2024.
3. The Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
