## PRODUCTION TARGET RETRACTION

Patagonia Lithium Ltd (ASX:PL3, Patagonia or Company) advises that the Company released a Maiden Mineral Resource Estimate (MRE) announcement titled "Significant Maiden Lithium Mineral Resource" (Announcement) and Mineral Resource presentation titled "Maiden Lithium Mineral Resource Presentation" (Presentation) on 22 January 2025. The Announcement and Presentation included reference to a 15 year mine life at a production rate of 10,000 tonnes annum. This represents an aspirational production target that may be achieved and not the actual planned production target from the reported MRE.

This disclosure may be interpreted as a production target (as defined in the listing rules), and the Company therefore advises that:

- Patagonia retracts the production target and mine life disclosed in the original Announcement and Presentation dated 22 January 2025;
- The production target has not been disclosed under compliance with the ASX Listing Rule 5.16 and is conceptual in nature. The technical feasibility and the economic viability of the production target is currently unknown; and
- Investors should not rely on this information to make any investment decisions in the Company.
