KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, the undersigned director and/or officer (or nominee) of Alcoa Corporation, a Delaware corporation (the "Company"), hereby constitute and appoint Andrew Hastings, Marissa P. Earnest, Megan C. Yancey, Mary A.
