#### **REQUEST FOR TRADING HALT**

Flynn Gold Limited (ASX: **FG1**) (the **Company**) requests an immediate halt to the trading of the Company's securities (ASX: FG1 & FG10) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.
