








FY25 H1 Cash Flow

1H FY24 Operating cash burn of \$2.9m




Santos required renewable, controllable, continuous base load power on a cost-effective basis, to replace banks of gas and diesel generators as the current source of power.

Successfully integrated 3 Powerhouse installations into Santos' control and supervision system, powering 15 remote gas wells in the Roma area, Queensland.

- At scale, through a multi-year expansion plan, the system is saving > 1M tonnes of carbon emissions across thousands of wells




