**REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION – FREEHILL MINING LIMITED (ASX:FHS)**

Freehill Mining Limited (ASX:FHS) (**Company**) refers to the trading halt of its securities granted by ASX on 15 April 2025.

The Company requests that a voluntary suspension of its securities be granted in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2 from the commencement of trading on Thursday, 17 April 2025.

The Company provides the following information in relation to the request:

1. the voluntary suspension is requested as the Company is not yet in a position to make an announcement regarding:
  - a. entry into a lease for a new premises to expand the Company's material processing operations (**New Project**); and
  - b. a placement and an entitlement offer (**Capital Raising**).
2. the voluntary suspension is necessary to prevent trading in the Company's securities on an uninformed basis, pending the announcement regarding the New Project, the results of the placement and the details of the entitlement offer under the Capital Raising;
3. the Company requests that the voluntary suspension remain in place until the earlier of an announcement by the Company regarding the New Project and the Capital Raising and the commencement of normal trading on Tuesday, 22 April 2025; and
4. the Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted, nor any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension. The Company also confirms that it has not concluded the proposed placement.
