Oakton Limited (Oakton) - Request for trading halt pursuant to Listing Rule 17.1

The directors of Oakton Limited (ASX: OKN) (**Oakton**) request a trading halt from the commencement of trading on Friday, 7 November 2014.

As announced to ASX on Friday, 31 October 2014, Oakton shareholders have approved the scheme of arrangement between Oakton and its shareholders (**Scheme**). This trading halt is sought in relation to today's second court hearing in the Supreme Court of Victoria at which orders will be sought to approve the Scheme.

Oakton requests that the trading halt remains in place until the commencement of trading on Monday, 10 November 2014 or until Oakton makes an announcement regarding the outcome of the court hearing, whichever occurs first.

Oakton confirms that it is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.
