South Australia Minister for Health Update

26 November 2014: Global Health Limited advises that the SA Minister for Health wishes to negotiate the terms upon which it may license CHIRON, beyond the 31 March 2015 cessation date. The Minister has further indicated that it may seek to agree or determine the terms of use with the Company's wholly-owned subsidiary, Working Systems Software Pty Ltd, pursuant to the Crown licensing regime for Commonwealth and State governments under the Copyright Act 1968 (Cth).

The broad philosophy behind section 183 is to allow Commonwealth and State governments to have access to intellectual property which is necessary to perform their administrative functions/achieve a "public good", without fear of IP infringement action from copyright owners.

Under the compulsory licensing regime, SA Health must agree the terms of their use of CHIRON with Global Health, or failing such agreement, have the terms of use determined by the Copyright Tribunal of Australia.

The 1.5c reduction to EPS as announced on Friday 21 November 2014, is considered a likely scenario only if the negotiations proposed by the SA Minister for Health is not successful.

The Company confirms that it is in compliance with Listing Rule 3.1 in relation to continuous disclosure and requests the trading halt to be lifted.
