- ♦ NPAT loss \$6.2M, includes impairment charge \$4.6M


## **Summary**

- Climate change policy uncertainty deferred energy plant projects.





# TSF Engineering & Maintenance



#### **Business Focus**

Clean Energy Generation comprising cogeneration, trigeneration & gas fired power plants to the manufacturing, mining and building sectors.

## **Strategic Growth**

- Operations and Maintenance contracts underpin growth in FY15 as customers replace CAPEX with OPEX.
- Operations and Maintenance business now 30% segment revenue, high growth area.
- Clean energy solutions include plant waste conversion to gas through anaerobic digestion.

# TSF Engineering & Maintenance



- Operations and maintenance contracts delivering recurrent revenue with uplift for unscheduled repairs and breakdowns. Maintenance contracts largely annual terms renewable without return to market.
- Project commencement delays due to gas pricing uncertainty combined with lack of clarity in federal government climate change policy.
- Melbourne Airport project to be completed in early 2015.
