Response to media speculation regarding legal matter with Victorian Government.

As reported in today's "The Australian" newspaper, the company confirms it has commenced proceedings in the Supreme Court against the Victorian Higher Education and Skills Group in regards to the 2014 funding contract of Consider This Training.

This legal matter relates to the action taken by the department in relation to Consider This Training which was announced to the market on 3 July 2015.

Whilst the company is not in a position to comment on the matter it can draw shareholders attention to the body of today's article where it stated that the company had provided 130 Statutory Declarations from the students in question which contradicted the view of the report.

The company reiterates that the amount of money involved is not material to the company, however, the company still will strongly pursue this matter.
