## Payment of final deferred consideration for Todoautos business and assets

#### Melbourne, Australia; 1 October 2015:

LatAm Autos Limited (the Company) is pleased to announce that further to its market announcement made on 19 June 2015, it has issued to the nominees of the vendor of the todoautos.com.pe businesses, Netmedia S.A.C. (the Vendor), 1,122,842 fully paid ordinary shares in the Company at an issue price of \$0.3005 (30.05 cents) per share in full settlement of the third tranche of consideration proceeds for the acquisition of those businesses.

The number of Shares issued to the Vendor has been calculated on the basis of the amount of the agreed settlement amount, in Australian dollars determined by reference to the Bloomberg exchange rate on October 1, 2015, at an issue price equal to the 5-day volume weighted average Share price over the 5 preceding ASX trading days to October 1, 2015.

Furthermore, the Vendor has agreed that all of the Shares will be escrowed upon issue, with 50% of the Shares to be escrowed for a period of 3 months from the date of issue, and the remaining 50% to be escrowed for 6 months from the date of issue.
