AIRSONEA RESEARCH STUDY APPROVED BY INSTITUTIONAL REVIEW BOARD

AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

iSonea is pleased to advise that Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval has been received to

conduct a research study of our home monitoring device, AirSonea, at the prestigious University

of Chicago in the division of Medicine & Biological Sciences.

The Principal Investigator will be Professor Edward T Naureckas, MD, Professor of Medicine and

Director of the Pulmonary Function Laboratory and the Adult Cystic Fibrosis Program. Dr.

Naureckas is an expert in the pulmonary conditions including asthma, adult cystic fibrosis and

chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). He specialises in pulmonary function testing to

determine the cause and severity of complex lung disorders.

This study will collect and record breath sounds data using AirSonea platform from patients in

all age groups (infants to geriatrics) under realistic ambient conditions. The study hypothesis is

that the AirSonea is at least as accurate (sensitive and specific) in detection and quantifying

wheeze as the consensus of: (a) physicians and (b) a panel of technical experts who evaluate

these recordings.

This study will commence soon and will include 90 subjects. The duration of the study will be

determined shortly.
