- We have a successful business model with a high level of recurring revenue which delivers growth and profits, which we largely distribute as dividends.









#### FY15 REVIEW\_

- Delivered Sydney and Auckland airport systems, making us the clear leader in this region
- Paid dividend in line with Prospectus full year \$11.3c /share.


#### GROWTH MARKET DRIVEN BY UTILITY EVOLUTION

- Utilities are focussed on meter-to-cash digitisation
  - Customer engagement now a key driver of the retail business model and efficient service delivery
