Fraser Range nickel drilling program update

Aircore drilling completed - results due later this month

- Reconnaissance aircore drilling program completed at Fraser Range nickel project in WA
- Results will be used to further refine priority targets located just 20km from Sirius' Nova-Bollinger nickel-copper discoveries
- Extensive soil sampling program for nickel underway at Fraser Range South, located 2km from Sirius' Centauri target

Ram Resources (ASX: RMR) is pleased to advise that the reconnaissance aircore drilling program at Fraser Range nickel project in WA has been completed (Figure 1).

Just over 2300m of drilling was undertaken for 71 vertical drill holes with an average depth of 37m. Samples from the bottom of the holes will be sent for multi-element assays in the coming days, with results expect towards the end of this month.

Ram's Fraser Range Project is located just 20km from Sirius' Nova-Bollinger nickel-copper discoveries.

The aircore program was aimed at further refining six high-priority targets. The results will be used to refine Ram's exploration targets in preparation for the next phase of deeper RC drilling to test a number of previously identified electro-magnetic (**EM**) conductors, considered prospective for nickel sulphide mineralisation.

At Ram's Fraser Range South Project, about 1000 soil samples are currently being collected. Ram has also commissioned Southern Geoscience (SGS) to identify possible intrusive bodies on the Fraser Range South Project. As part of this, SGS will reprocess the Geological Survey WA magnetics to refine exploration targets.

The Fraser Range South Project is located on the same structure as Sirius' Centauri prospect.

Ram Managing Director Bill Guy said the Company had an aggressive exploration campaign underway across its three Fraser Range nickel projects, which cover a total of 850sqkm.

"These programs will generate strong newsflow over coming weeks and months, culminating in deeper drilling at what are emerging as very promising targets," Mr Guy said.
