

Class Action

Cash Converters International Limited ("the Company") wishes to clarify that the judgement handed down on 1 September 2014 by the Full Federal Court (Cash Converters International Limited v Gray [2014] FCAFC 111) related to technical legal questions to do with the proper construction of section 33C(1) of the Federal Court Act. It arose out of an objection by the Company to the pleadings filed by the plaintiff.

This decision has nothing to do with the actual merits of the case which was commenced in October, 2013. The nature of the claim and the Company's defence to the claim has not changed since October, 2013 and the case continues.
