ARUMA COMMENCES EXPLORATION ON TWO FRONTS

- Bulloo Downs Copper Project HyMap survey commences
- Aircore drilling starts at Glandore Gold Project

Diversified West Australian explorer **Aruma Resources Limited (ASX: AAJ)** ("Aruma") is pleased to advise that exploration activity commenced this week at its Bulloo Downs Copper Project in the state's Ashburton Region and its Glandore Gold Project, near Kalgoorlie.

The Company has started geological surveying using HyMap technology at Bulloo Downs, as well as a program of aircore drilling at Glandore.

BULLOO DOWNS

Since the last mapping program was completed within the Bulloo Downs lease areas, Aruma has extended the strike length of the mapped structures and identified gossans with widths of up to 10m. The new program will see the Company flying over 1,720km² using HyVista Multispectral Scanning (HyMap), with the data to be combined with data collected from the previous 1,050km² program to define and confirm further mineralisation targets.

Table 1 above summarises the extent and tenor of the mapped mineralisation. The gossans are large by comparison to other gossans in Western Australia.




Figure 1: Bulloo Downs Copper project with HyMap coverage in black dashed outline

GLANDORE




Figure 2: Google ® image with Fluid Flow drilling targets at Glandore

Aircore drilling of the northern lake area at Glandore has also commenced with a specialised salt lake aircore rig. Some 3,000m in 50m deep holes was planned but the holes are being drilled to around 60m before refusal, hence some 4,000m will be drilled for the program. The holes are shown in Figure 2 below.

The softer nature of the ground being drilled has allowed Aruma to extend the drill coverage with the deep weathering reflecting the altered nature of the rocks in the Fluid Flow Target areas. In previous drilling to the south, fresh rock was intersected at depths as shallow as 5 to 10 m.

The drilling program is expected to last about 8 days, and the samples will be assayed in Kalgoorlie, with the results expected in October.
