Tranche 2 of Placement to raise \$725,000 Completed and Appendix 3B

Taruga Gold Limited (**Taruga** or the **Company**) advises that shares issued under Tranche 2 of the Company's recent Placement (**Placement**) were allotted today, 7 October 2014.

Taruga has today issued 145,000,000 fully paid ordinary shares at \$0.005 per share and 46,250,000 unlisted options, raising \$725,000. Together with the funds raised under Tranche 1 of the Placement and the share purchase plan, the Company has successfully raised a total of \$992,000 pursuant to the capital raising activities announced on 27 August 2014.

The funds raised will be used to accelerate near-term drilling programs at the Company's highly prospective projects in Mali as well as to conduct geochemical sampling within the granted Cote d'Ivoire projects.
