Westminster Installation – Completion of Phase 1

Smart Parking Ltd (ASX:SPZ or **Company**) is pleased to advise that the installation of 3,000 of its parking sensors across London's Westminster City Council (**Council**) has been completed.

The sensors are operational and providing real-time data to the Council for use in the live parking app being deployed by the Council. This improves regulation of parking within the Council and allows motorists in Westminster to locate a parking space more efficiently, reducing stress, congestion and vehicle emissions.

The installation follows a successful pilot project in streets including Saville Row, Jermyn Street and St John's Wood High Street. This is the first phase of the sensor programme and it is planned to roll out a further 7,000 sensors across the rest of the Council.
