MetalsTech Limited - Request for Voluntary Suspension

Pursuant to Listing Rule 17.2, MetalsTech Limited ("MetalsTech" or the "Company") hereby requests that a voluntary suspension of the entity's securities be granted by the Australian Securities Exchange ("ASX") in respect of MetalsTech's securities (ASX:MTC):

In accordance with Listing Rule 17.2, the Company advises:

- That it is seeking a voluntary suspension pending a material announcement regarding high grade gold assays from the current diamond drilling program at the Sturec Gold Mine;
- It anticipates that the voluntary suspension end on the earlier of the commencement of normal trading on Wednesday 28 October 2020 or when an announcement is released to the market; and
