Phase 2 Drill Program Completed Edjudina Gold Project, WA

Gibb River Diamonds Limited ('GIB' or the 'Company') is pleased to announce the completion of the Phase 2 drill program at the Edjudina Gold Project.

The Phase 2 aircore drilling program tested strike extension targets to the north and south of the Neta Lodes gold discovery and also the Gawler Prospect. A total of 5,961 metres were drilled. Final samples were delivered to the assay lab on 30 November.

Despite two early rig breakdowns delaying the program, more targets were tested and more metres were drilled than originally planned. This in turn has delayed the reporting, however, we are aiming to ensure these results are reported prior to the Christmas break.
