NOTICE UNDER SECTION 708A OF THE CORPORATIONS ACT

This notice is given by 4DS Memory Limited (“Issuer”) under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (“Act”).

The Issuer on 14 December 2020 issued 2,000,000 Shares at an issue price of \$0.042 per share following the exercise of 2,000,000 27 October 2022 unlisted options (the “Issued Shares”).
