On behalf of the Board of Wiluna Mining Corporation Limited (ACN 119 887 606) (**Company**), I am pleased to offer eligible shareholders the opportunity to participate in the Company's Share Purchase Plan (**Plan**), by subscribing for up to \$30,000 worth of fully paid ordinary shares in the Company (**Shares**) (subject to any scale back) without having to pay brokerage or other transaction costs, and subject to the enclosed terms and conditions (**Offer**).

1. General

1.1 Important information

- (b) The Plan does not take into account the individual investment objectives, financial situation or particular needs of any Eligible Shareholder.
- (c) If you are in any doubt as to whether you should participate in the Offer, or how such participation will affect you (including taxation implications), you should contact your professional adviser without delay.
- (d) Neither the Company nor any of its Directors make any recommendation in relation to the Offer.

1.2 Offer

- (m) authorise the Company (and each of its officers and agents) to correct any error in your Application Form and to complete the Application Form by inserting any missing details;
- (n) accept the risk associated with any refund that may be sent to you at your address as shown on the member register; and
- (o) are responsible for any dishonour fees or other costs the Company may incur in presenting a cheque for payment which is dishonoured.

8. Issue of and quotation Shares

8.1 Issue of Shares

- (a) The Shares issued under the Offer will be issued within 7 business days after the Closing Date or such other period required by the ASX Listing Rules.
- (b) All Shares issued under the Offer will rank equally with existing fully paid ordinary shares issued in the capital of the Company.
- (c) Other terms and conditions, rights and obligations of and relating to Shares are contained in the Company's constitution.



8.2 Quotation of Shares

The Company will apply to ASX for the quotation of the Shares issued under the Offer as soon as practicable after the issue or within such other time period required by the ASX Listing Rules.

8.3 Holding statements or notifications

Shareholding statements or CHESS notification will be issued in respect of all Shares issued under the Plan.

9. Use of funds

9.1 Present intention

The Board presently intends that the funds raised from the Offer, together with funds raised by the Company's placement announced on 4 December 2020 of approximately \$22.55 million, will be applied towards increasing the rate of the drilling programme to expand the Company's reserves and resources, increasing the rate and quantum of the Company's underground mine development for the sulphide development programme, feasibility work associated with Stage 2 expansion to 250,000 ounces of annual gold production and for general working capital.

9.2 Discretion to alter

As with any intended budget or use of funds, this is a statement of current intentions as at the date of this Offer. Intervening events and new circumstances have the potential to affect the manner in which the funds are ultimately applied. The Board reserves the right to alter the way the funds are applied on this basis.

10. Offer amount and scale back policy

10.1 Offer amount

The Company reserves the right to determine the aggregate amount it raises through the Offer. At this stage, the maximum amount sought to be raised under the Offer is \$2,002,000, though the Company reserves the right to change this cap at its discretion by announcement to ASX (subject to the maximum permitted under the ASX Listing Rules, which restricts the number of new Shares that may be issued under the Offer to 30% of the number of Shares currently on issue).

10.2 Scale back

The Company may in its discretion scale back your application for Shares under the Offer to the extent and in the manner it sees fit.

If total demand for the Offer exceeds \$2,002,000, the Company reserves the right to close the Offer early and scale back applications in its absolute and sole discretion. When determining the amount (if any) by which to scale back an application under the Offer, the Company may consider a number of factors, including the size of an applicant's shareholding in the Company, the extent to which an applicant has sold or bought additional Shares in the Company after the Record Date and the date on which an application was made.

If there is a scale back, you may receive less than the parcel of Shares for which you have applied.



10.3 Rounding

If a scale back produces a fractional number of Shares when applied to your parcel, the number of Shares you will be issued will be rounded up to the nearest whole number of Shares.

10.4 Refunds

In the event of a scale back in accordance with this paragraph 9, the difference between the value of the Shares you are issued (calculated using the Issue Price) and the application money you paid will be refunded to you by the Company, without interest, following the issue date of the Shares under the Offer.

11. Variation, termination and waiver

11.1 Variation

The Company reserves the right at any time to:

- (a) amend or vary these Terms and Conditions;
- (b) withdraw the Offer or suspend or terminate the Plan;
- (c) not accept an application, not issue Shares or issue Shares to a value less than that applied for under the Offer by an Eligible Shareholder (including a Custodian applying on behalf of its Participating Beneficiaries).

11.2 Notification to ASX

If the Company amends or varies the Terms and Conditions, withdraws, suspends or terminates the Offer it will notify ASX. The non-receipt of any such notice to ASX will not invalidate the amendment, variation, withdrawal, suspension or termination.

11.3 Refunds

- (a) If the Offer is withdrawn or terminated, all of your application monies will be refunded to you.
- (b) No interest will be paid on any money returned to you.

11.4 Waiver

The Company reserves the right to waive strict compliance with any provision of these Terms and Conditions.

12. Dispute resolution

The Company may settle any difficulties, anomalies, or disputes which may arise in connection with the operation of the Plan and/or the Offer whether generally or in relation to any participant or any application for Shares in any manner it deems appropriate, and its decision shall be conclusive and binding on all participants and other persons to whom the determination relates.



13. Governing law

- (a) These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws in force in Western Australia.
- (b) Any dispute arising out of, or in connection with, these Terms and Conditions, or the Offer, will be determined by the courts of Western Australia. By accepting the Offer, you agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Western Australia.
