BPH Energy Ltd (ASX: BPH) (the Company) requests an immediate halt to the trading of the Company's ordinary shares and options quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.

The trading halt is requested pending an announcement to be made by the Company with respect to the appointment of specialist consultant on the environmental program for the PEP 11 permit.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the Company provides the following information in relation to the request:

- 1. The trading halt is necessary to assist the Company in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as the Company expects to make a material announcement to the market in relation to the stated purpose.
- 2. The Company requests that the trading halt remains in place until the earlier of commencement of normal trading on Monday1st March 2021, or when the announcement regarding the stated purpose is released to the market.
- 3. The Company expects to make the announcement to the market before the commencement of normal trading on Monday 1st March 2021.
