Request for Voluntary Suspension

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Australian Potash Limited (**APC** or the **Company**) requests that the securities of the Company be placed in voluntary suspension with immediate effect. The Company advises that:

1. The voluntary suspension is requested in connection with the resolution to the Company's application to the Supreme Court of Western Australia seeking orders to rectify an administrative oversight, as previously advised to the market on Tuesday 23 March 2021. The Company notes that the hearing of its application is scheduled to be heard in the Supreme Court of Western Australia at 9.15am on Friday, 26 March 2021;
2. The Company requests that the voluntary suspension remains in place until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market in relation to the above and the commencement of trading on Monday 29 March 2021; and,
3. The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market or ASX about the request.
