

ADELONG GOLDFIELD DRILLING UNDERWAY

Highlights

- Drilling program is well underway on the Challenger Gold Project with six (6) holes primarily completed
- Program will provide the detailed information on resources for mine optimisation
- Additional targets being evaluated at Caledonian Gold Project

3D Resources Limited (**ASX:DDD**) (**3D Resources** or the **Company**) is pleased to advise that the drilling at the Adelong Goldfield in Southern New South Wales, is well underway with drilling almost complete on the sixth hole as at Monday 21st June for a total of 768 metres drilled.

Commenting on the drilling activity, 3D Resources Managing Director, Mr Peter Mitchell, said:

"It is good to see the RC program at Adelong running smoothly, with all the holes reaching target depths and without any delays.

We retain a positive view that this drilling program will provide the detailed information on resources needed to expand the potential development at Challenger.

Given excellent progress in the drilling we hope to extend the program and take advantage of the numerous exploration targets."

Challenger Drill Program

As announced on <u>11 June 2021</u>, DRC Drilling have been contracted to complete an initial twelve (12) drill hole program at the Challenger Gold Project. Eleven (11) of the holes are designed to infill some of the existing drilling information to allow the mine plan to be optimised and improve the understanding of the transition from a possible open pit to underground mining.

The remaining drill hole is within the planned open cut mine and aims to provide additional data on the nature of the waste rock likely to be generated from mining operations and how this can be managed effectively. The first shipment of samples have been sent to ALS Orange for fire assay.

Additional Drill Program

A follow up site visit to the other prime targets at the Adelong Goldfield has revealed that the Caledonian Gold Project area is currently accessible. The Company has reviewed options for extending this current program to include several exploration drill holes aimed at potentially extending and better evaluating the resources at Caledonian. The Exploration Manager has planned an extension to the program of five (5) drill holes for a total of 810m which will be completed post the initial program at Challenger, subject to drilling contractor availability.
