

Extraordinary General Meeting on 12 August 2021 Update: Change from Physical to Virtual Meeting

The Board of Shekel Brainweigh Limited (ASX: SBW) provides an update for its Extraordinary General Meeting ("EGM") being held at 5.00pm (AEST) on Thursday 12 August 2021.

As announced by the NSW Government, all of greater Sydney, the Blue Mountains, Wollongong and the Central Coast have been placed in COVID-19 lockdown at least until Thursday 28 August 2021.

Given the significant health concerns attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in Sydney, NSW, in addition to guidelines and restrictions issued by Australian state and federal governments, the Company considers that it is appropriate to hold the EGM as a virtual meeting, with all shareholders to attend the meeting through the virtual meeting accessible online. This is in a manner that is consistent with the Australian Securities and Investment Commission ("ASIC") 'no-action position' released on 29 March 2021 and SBW's Articles of Association.

The Notice of the EGM ("Notice") was dispatched to shareholders on 6 July 2021 by post and electronically and can be viewed and downloaded online at the following link:

Given the uncertainty surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, by the time of the EGM, circumstances may have changed but this update is given based on circumstances as at 9 August 2021. Shareholders are urged to monitor the ASX announcements platform and the Company's website.

All resolutions will be decided on a poll. The poll will be conducted based on votes submitted by proxy and at the Meeting by shareholders who have indicated that they intend to vote at the Meeting in accordance with the instructions set out below.

The Company requests all shareholders wishing to participate at the EGM to attend the meeting virtually.

Shareholders will be able to vote and ask questions at the virtual meeting.

Voting virtually at the Meeting

Shareholders who wish to vote virtually on the day of the EGM will need to login to the Automic website (https://investor.automic.com.au/#/home) with their *username* and *password*.

Shareholders who do not have an account with Automic are strongly encouraged to register for an account **as soon as possible and well in advance of the Meeting** to avoid any delays on the day of the Meeting.

- 3. **(Live voting on the day)** If live voting for the virtual meeting is open, click on 'Meeting open for voting' and follow the steps.
