Highlights

- K-Brite[™] Potassium Sulphate SOP certified as compliant with the requirements set out in the Australian Certified Organic Standard 2021 (Version 1)
- ACO Certification Ltd (ACO) is Australia's largest certifier for organic and biodynamic produce with over
 2,000 operators currently under its certification system
- 20,000 tonnes of organically certified K-Brite[™] Potassium Sulphate SOP is to be distributed under takeor-pay offtake agreement with Redox throughout Australia and New Zealand's diverse agriculture markets
- ACO organic certification follows:
 - OMRI certification covering the US markets where APC has a 20,000 tonne per annum take-orpay offtake agreement in place with HELM USA; and
 - ECOCERT classification of K-BriteTM Potassium Sulphate SOP as suitable for use in organic farming in Europe where APC has a 30,000 tonne per annum offtake agreement with HELM

Managing Director and CEO, Matt Shackleton, commented: "We are strategically positioning the Lake Wells sulphate of potash suite of K-BriteTM products to sell into the premium end of global SOP markets.

"We believe that making premium end products that are organically certified and have a high potassium content, and which will be delivered in granulated and bagged forms, gives our shareholders the best opportunity to generate premium margins. Having our products organically certified in the Australian markets is obviously a milestone step in this overall strategy.

"APC has secured offtake agreements for 90% of our forecast annual production, or 150,000 tonnes per annum, across Europe, the US, Australia and New Zealand, China and SE Asia. It is the preference for organic produce in these markets, which generally commands a price premium, that we are targeting with our suite of organically certified K-Brite™ SOP products."
