Statement pursuant to Listing Rule 4.7C.1

Telecommunications innovator Vonex Limited ("Vonex" or the "Company") (ASX: VN8) provides the following supplemental information to the Company's September 2021 quarterly activities report in accordance with Listing Rule 4.7C.1.

The net operating cash inflow for the September 2021 quarter was \$0.4 million from cash receipts of \$7.05 million (June quarter: outflow of \$0.12 million on \$4.5 million in cash receipts). Quarterly expenditure was in line with internal budgets and was focused on the following areas:

- Cost of goods relating to sales across the wholesale and retail divisions, including the renewal of the Qantas Business Rewards partnership amounted to \$4.083 million
- Transaction expenses associated with the acquisition of the MNF Group direct business of \$0.430 million
- Advertising and marketing including investments in cross-selling opportunities of \$0.082 million
- Employment and consulting costs of \$1.088 million
- Channel Partner training and expansion of \$0.069 million
- Continual improvements to the Company's systems and data security of \$0.160 million
