

PENTANET TO PRESENT AT UPCOMING CONFERENCE

Pentanet Limited (**ASX:5GG, Pentanet or Company**) is pleased to provide an updated investor video presentation for the Euroz Hartleys 2022 Rottnest Island Institutional Investors Conference. The presentation by Pentanet Managing Director Stephen Cornish provides an update on the Company's activities including the rollout of neXus and GeForce NOW Powered by Pentanet.

Pentanet has one of the largest Fixed Wireless networks in Perth, offering unparalleled network reliability and scalability. As the Company continues to rapidly grow its internet subscriber base, the forward-looking focus is the expansion of the network footprint of neXus – Pentanet's next-generation gigabit-enabled wireless mesh network.

The neXus marketing campaign has so far generated more than 8,000 registrations from the community, who registered their interest to form part of the initial neXus deployment. The Company is encouraged by this strong level of interest, with these initial registrations theoretically creating additional capacity for 192,000 neXus subscribers. The theoretical capacity is calculated by mapping the location of registrations as initial distribution points, and then determining the number of premises that can then be served by that distribution point. It represents a simulated network capacity that will ultimately be dependent on the number of distribution points installed. Each Meshy Boi added to the network enables 20-25 more subscribers depending on existing network density. Planning is underway to find the 1,000 installation sites that will provide the highest rate of coverage and return for the capital investment.

Initial neXus deployments have commenced, and the Company is targeting the activation of the first wave of revenue generating connections to Perth homes in Q4 FY22.

The Company's cloud gaming platform, GeForce NOW Powered by Pentanet, has jumped from 20,000 Beta Play testers to now more than 100,000 active members across two available subscription types. To date, the platform has powered more than 55 million minutes of game time, equivalent to over 104 years of gameplay hosted in the cloud.

Pentanet's Basic subscription tier gives curious gamers the opportunity to test the platform on their network and hardware free of charge and is currently being used to capture this brand-new Australian market. Players can then upgrade to a Priority subscription for \$19.99 per month, giving them access to extended session times, priority access to game servers, and the ability to take advantage of NVIDIA's RTX or 'ray-tracing' technologies within the platform, which materially improves the graphic quality of compatible games with little to no impact on performance.

As Pentanet continues to successfully demonstrate that cloud gaming is possible on Australia's internet infrastructure, the Company will focus on converting more users onto a paid subscription by introducing new tiers of plans between Basic and Priority. These are expected to be released in Q4 FY22.

Cloud gaming is a developing market across the world, with Pentanet one of the leaders in the Australian market. A report published by Newzoo¹ has predicted that the global market for cloud gaming will more than quadruple over the next few years, from an estimated USD\$1.57 billion in August of 2021 to USD\$6.53 billion by the end of 2024. Cloud gaming has taken a long time to make it to Australia thanks to our connectivity challenges, but with next-generation internet about to hit the market and average download speeds increasing across the country, the barriers to entry for cloud gaming are about to get even smaller.

GeForce NOW Powered by Pentanet is a highly complementary service to Pentanet's premium telecommunications offerings as high-quality internet is required for the optimal cloud gaming experience. The Company's near-term focus is demonstrating the power of neXus and optimising the network for the Perth market. However, as the Company's cloud gaming efforts continue to gain national recognition for the Pentanet brand, there exists an opportunity to convert GeForce NOW Powered by Pentanet subscribers across the country into neXus subscribers should Pentanet replicate its Perth network nationally.
