Recommended and Unconditional Takeover Offer for Bullseve – End of Withdrawal Period

Emerald Resources NL (ASX: EMR) ("Emerald") refers to its previous announcements in relation to its recommended and unconditional takeover bid for all of the issued shares of Bullseye Mining Limited (Bullseye) that it does not already own (Offer).

Emerald can advise that following the expiry of the withdrawal rights period at 5:00pm (WST) on Monday 7 March 2022, it has a relevant interest in 49.41% of the 445,599,851 Bullseye shares currently on issue, comprising:

- 75,692,283 shares held directly by Emerald; and
- 144,458,134 shares pursuant to acceptances of the Offer by Bullseye shareholders.

It was the Company's intention to issue Emerald shares to accepting Bullseye shareholders as soon as practical. However, as announced today, the Takeovers Panel have advised that they are conducting proceedings in relation to a further application made by Hongkong Xinhe International Investment Company Limited dated 28 February 2022 in respect of Emerald's recommended and unconditional takeover offer for Bullseye (Proceedings).

In light of the Proceedings, Emerald has provided an undertaking to the Panel that it will not, without the Panel's consent, take steps, or allow any steps to be taken, to process acceptances of, or issue any Emerald shares to, accepting Bullseye shareholders pursuant to the Bid or take any action to enforce clause 2.4 of the Bid Implementation Agreement (as announced on 7 December 2021), or otherwise accept an offer to nominate directors to the board of Bullseye, until the determination of Panel proceedings.

The closing date of the Offer is 5pm (WST) on Friday 18 March 2022 (unless otherwise extended).

"We respect that the Takeover Panel wishes to conduct proceedings in relation to this latest application and look forward to issuing freely tradeable Emerald shares to those Bullseye shareholders that have accepted our Offer as soon as we are permitted so as to formalise our robust position as the largest shareholder of Bullseye at 49.41%.

"For those Bullseye shareholders, the majority of which are domiciled in China and Ireland, that are yet to accept our Offer, we urge you to do so to avoid continuing to hold your shares privately in Bullseye with limited liquidity."
