**REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION**

Sprintex Limited (“Sprintex” or the “Company”) requests voluntary suspension of its securities, pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, prior to the commencement of trading on Tuesday 29 March 2022.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the Company provides the following information regarding this request:

1. As set out in the trading halt request of 24 March 2022, an application is being made to the Court by the Company regarding rectification of a technical compliance issue. The Company is examining whether a cleansing prospectus should be issued or whether in the circumstances it should seek an order from the Court in relation to lodging a cleansing prospectus for shares issued on 9 February 2022.
2. The voluntary suspension will operate until the announcement is made in relation to this matter, which is estimated to be by 5 April 2022.
3. Sprintex is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted.
4. Sprintex is not aware of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
