- Using InteliCare technology, WA Country Health Service launches a \$101,691 assisted technology pilot program to support ageing residents to live as independently as possible in residential aged care.
- The current care model will be supported by the new technologically assisted living environment and factor in behaviour analytics, falls detection and vitals monitoring.
- The pilot program is in line with WA Country Health Service's mission to deliver and advance high-quality care for country WA communities.

InteliCare Holdings Ltd ("InteliCare" or the "Company") (ASX: ICR), an Australian technology company that has commercialised a subscription-based Internet of Things (IoT) and Artificial Intelligence (AI) product for use in the aged care and health industries, is pleased to announce its participation in an upcoming pilot project with WA Country Health Service.

Further expansion into the remote and regional care market

The \$101,691 pilot program will measure the efficiency of InteliCare's assistive technology solution in supporting residents to live independently. Additionally, it will provide WA Country Health Service with a non-intrusive system to improve resident safety and wellbeing. This supports ageing in place and reduces the need for escalation of care.

60% of the project funding will be awarded to InteliCare on the project commencement. The remaining 40% will be awarded to the company with the completion of pre-determined project milestones.

Providing tech solutions to a remote assisted living environment

InteliCare's predictive analytics mobile and dashboard platform, InteliLiving®, enables elderly and disabled people to live with independence and dignity. By combining discreet sensors, emergency alerts, and health devices, InteliLiving® provides multiple layers of wellbeing intelligence and insight.

These insights will be used to assist WA Country Health Service to proactively detect and respond to changes in resident behaviour, and promote good health and wellbeing.

WA Country Health Service is committed to embracing innovation and technology for the betterment of health services, as outlined in their Strategic Plan.



Market size and opportunity

The 12-month PoC of InteliLiving could provide contemporary evidence towards the success of datafocused remote and regional aged care.

A formal evaluation process will take place.

InteliCare hopes to replicate the model if successful.

The InteliCare PoC aligns to WA Health's Sustainable Health Review recommendation to 'invest in digital healthcare and use data wisely'.

Jason Waller, CEO InteliCare, says: "InteliCare has previously worked with WA Country Health Service with a \$500,000 grant in 2017. We are excited to work with the organisation again and to me, this reaffirms the innovative and valuable work we are achieving for our partners. It is our goal that the success of the PoC will be recognised and may even be expanded, with the aim of providing Australians living in rural areas greater independence and data-driven care."
