Trading Halt

The Directors of Cyprium Metals Limited (**Cyprium** or the **Company**) request an immediate trading halt of its securities from ASX, from the commencement of trading on 4 July 2022 (**Trading Halt**).

As required by Listing Rule 17.1, Cyprium provides the following information:

- the Trading Halt is requested pending an application to be made to the Supreme Court of Western Australia (**Court**) by the Company seeking orders in relation to the Company's inadvertent administrative error to lodge a cleansing notice under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act in relation to the issue of shares on 11 December 2020;
- Cyprium requests that the Trading Halt continue until the earlier of its application being heard and determined by the Court and the commencement of trading on 6 July 2022;
- Cyprium is not aware of any reason why the Trading Halt should not be granted; and
- Cyprium has no other information necessary to inform the market about the Trading Halt.
