### Expiry of Escrow Restrictions

**Revolver Resources Holdings Limited (ASX: RRR)** advises that, in accordance with Listing Rule 3.10A, the following fully paid ordinary shares and unlisted options, which are currently classified as ASX restricted securities, will cease to be escrowed as followed:
