

Results of the 9th BMX Auction

IMPLIED PRICE OF US\$7,708/DMT (SC6.0, CIF CHINA)

Pilbara Minerals Limited (“**Pilbara Minerals**” or the “**Company**”: ASX: PLS) is pleased to announce the results of its latest spodumene concentrate auction, held via its digital Battery Material Exchange (“**BMX**”) platform, earlier this afternoon.

A cargo of 5,000dmt at a target grade of ~5.5% lithia was presented for sale on the digital platform, with delivery expected from mid October 2022.

Strong interest was received in both participation and bidding by a broad range of qualified buyers with a total of 22 bids received online during the 30-minute auction window.

Pilbara Minerals intends to accept the highest bid of US\$6,988/dmt (SC5.5, FOB Port Hedland basis) which on a pro rata basis for lithia content (and adjusted to be inclusive of freight costs) equates to a price of ~US\$7,708/dmt (SC6.0, CIF China basis).

Pursuant to the auction terms, the bidder is now required to enter a sales contract within 24 hours requiring a 10 percent deposit to be paid by weeks end and an irrevocable letter of credit from a recognised bank to be presented by late September 2022.
